The 11 liberal youth organizations present at the FNF/IFLRY seminar “Create a strategy for and with the Organizations of Young Liberals in Africa”, in Muldersdrift (Johannesburg), South Africa, of which 6 are full members of the Organization of African Liberal Youth,

As convened at this meeting hosted by the International Federation of Liberal Youth,

- Express their enthusiasm and willingness to revive the Organization of African Liberal Youth for the sake of freedom and democracy in Africa;
- Support the establishment of an official Congress of the Organization of African Liberal Youth, to take place within 6 months of today; to be executed by a committee consisting of the 6 full OALY members present here and the President of the OALY Bureau (or a replacement by him from the Bureau, or, if not possible, from among the OALY Full or Candidate Member Organizations), taking its decisions by majority voting; and for which all organizations who are present here will be invited;
- Commit themselves to the execution of the various projects that have been designed during the seminar, and to place them under the banner of OALY, in particular:
 - The creation or reinvigoration of the various communication tools, like the website, newsletter and e-mail list;
 - The setting up and coordination of the ‘OALY Speaks’ project;
 - The creation of an inventory of training needs and the development of training courses.

These projects will be worked out according to the responsibilities and the time-action plans as outlined during the seminar; specifically under the responsibility of the three project group coordinators (Koffi Maizan – Politics; David Pierre – Training; John Jaisey – Communication). The overall coordination of the projects as well as the integration of these projects into OALY will be in the hands of IFLRY Vice President Aïcha Camara.
