Our Mission:

FAIR Fund works internationally to engage youth, especially young women, in civil society in the areas of anti-human trafficking, domestic violence and sexual assault prevention, and the development of youth capacity-building programs. FAIR Fund believes that it is vital to mobilize and support youth in grassroots civic activism to effect positive social change; all programs are conceptualized and implemented with local partners in order to achieve empowering and sustainable results.

FAIR FUND PROVIDES

- ***expert testimony** in national and international cases of human trafficking and gender based violence asylum.
- ***a network** of over 700 college students in 12 countries on over 90 campuses who will be the next generation of social change activists
- ***resources for international students, teachers, and law enforcement** to use when working with youth at risk of or exposed to human trafficking

- *provide **anti-trafficking prevention and life skills education** to vulnerable youth leaving orphan care.
- *educate street children about **how to get help if they have been sexually exploited or trafficked.**
- *organize college and high school activists to raise awareness about sexual assault on school campuses
