Subject: Call – Nominations for IFLRY Climate Caucus

Dear friends,

The International Federation of Liberal Youth wishes to develop, deepen and expand the voice and activities of young liberals world-wide on the topic of climate change and climate-related policies at large in order to influence public debate and political decision-making. To that end, IFLRY has appointed an IFLRY Climate Change Project Manager and adopted an IFLRY Climate Programme. Furthermore, we have decided to compose an IFLRY Climate Caucus.

The IFLRY Climate Caucus shall consist of the IFLRY Climate Change Programme Manager and up to twelve representatives of Member Organizations who are competent in climate change issues. The IFLRY Climate Caucus shall serve to assist the IFLRY Bureau with the implementation of the IFLRY Climate Programme.

The main elements of the IFLRY Climate Programme are:

- To have IFLRY delegations participate in all major UNFCCC events;
- To develop a general IFLRY position on the issue of climate change as well as specific positions on current debates;
- To actively promote our positions within Liberal International;
- To brief MOs on potential activities including documentation;
- To archive all activities in one central activity database; and
- To organize or co-organize, as the case may be, young liberal climate change events, especially seminars.

It is foreseen that the IFLRY Climate Caucus will carry out its work mainly through online platforms and telecommunication. Physical meetings may be held in addition. The Caucus Members shall be appointed for the duration of one year.

Nominations for the IFLRY Climate Caucus are now open. Please submit a CV or Resume, as well as a motivation letter (minimum 200 words) in which you describe your motivation to be part of the Climate Caucus. Nominations should be submitted by an official representative (President, Secretary General or International Officer) of an IFLRY member organization no later than 15 October 2009 and should be sent to climatechange@iflry.org. The composition of the IFLRY Climate Caucus shall be decided upon by the IFLRY Bureau and shall be announced by 22 October 2009.
